NHS Track and Trace Use Privacy Notice for Families**

As children are beginning to return to school, we continue working hard to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all our children, staff and families. We have put measures in place within our school but we are very much aware our responsibilities continue outside the school gates.

A key part of the Government's measures to manage coronavirus is the use of the NHS Track and Trace scheme. As with all schools, we hold a lot of data and we may, on occasions, need to share some of the data we hold on request from a member of the NHS Track and Trace team.

As a school, we will share the requested data as part of our obligation to support the Government's strategy. This means it is likely we will be asked to provide contact details if a case of coronavirus is either confirmed or suspected in our school.

We will be sharing this information on the basis of Public Duty. If we are required to share any health details, we will do this as it is necessary for the public interest.

Please be assured we will keep a record of any information we share.
