5th May



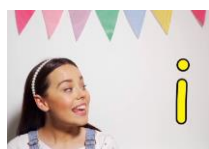

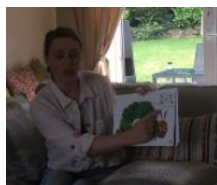
