In **red room** the children have continued to be the enveloping schema by painting on surfaces and then covering the paint in another colour or using cloths to wipe their marks away. This week outdoors we will provide laminated mats for the children to paint on, using a variety of different sized paint brushes and rollers. Indoors the children will explore the texture of bubble wrap and the marks that it creates on paper using paint. And then rolling pins wrapped in bubble wrap to support those children engaging in rotational schematic play.

In **green** room where the children have been making sounds by pouring, banging and tapping on different surfaces, this week we are going to explore canvas drum painting. Over the week the children will use a variety of tools to paint with including wooden pegs, beaters, lollypop sticks, brushes and their fingers. The children can listen to the sounds they make as they gently or firmly tap, bang and brush. We will also be linking this activity to their core story **The Drum** by repeating key phrases from the book as they play a steady beat.
