










This Weeks 'What's Happening'

Wednesday 16th June



In **red room** we have been reading our core story 'The Enormous Turnip' and learning about vegetables which grow in the ground. In keeping with children's repeating patterns of play with the enclosure schema, the children have been pulling out pictures of vegetables to learn their name. This week we will be playing a matching game so

that the children can match the vegetable pictures with the correctly labelled envelope. We will also be counting and comparing sizes of different vegetables.

Thursday 17th June

In **blue**, **yellow** and **green** rooms, the children continue to be interested in making marks with different media. They have been drawing pictures of themselves and painting on tiles. They have also been collecting natural materials outside and making a large collage. This week we will be painting pebbles our fingers and will also make marks with various materials in the playdough such as shells and beads.
