Tooth decay causes pain which can have a significant impact on speaking, eating and well-

being. The Bradford Oral Health Team will be here this **Wednesday** all day to complete and apply **fluoride varnish** which is a golden gel which is painted onto your child's teeth twice a year and when combined with daily tooth brushing will help prevent tooth decay.
