Including Punjabi roots Dhol drummers and Bangra dancers. Activities begin at 6pm from the Dome House. For more details on this and other events in the festival visit

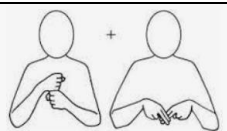

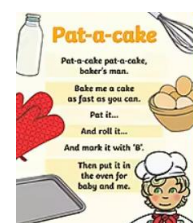


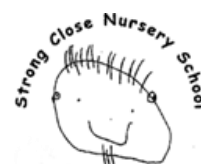

# Cooked Dough Recipe

Strong Close Nursery School, supporting  
parents/carers and children playing together

- Put 2 cups of self-raising flour into a bowl
- Add 1 cup of salt
- Add 1 tablespoon of oil
- Add 2 teaspoons of cream of tartar
- Add 2 cups of boiled water and mix until pliable.
- Allow to cool, and store in a well-sealed plastic bag or container.
