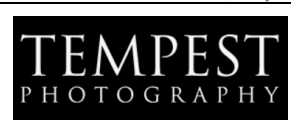




This Weeks 'What's Happening'

The Rough and The ...

Further to our visits to Hesketh Farm last week the children in **yellow, green and blue** rooms have been interested in the sheep's head sculpture that Lou our artist brought in and which is made from clay. The children then used their own pieces of clay to make a representational model. This week we will explore clay in more depth by making patterns, adding materials such as cardboard and using different tools to create marks. Playing with dough and clay helps your child to strengthen muscles tone, and develop fine motor and pre- writing skills. 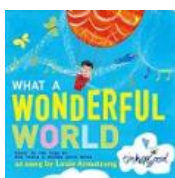
