The main barriers to learning on entry were The main focus from 2021 2022 assessment analysis was Literacy and Mathematics. On autumn 2022 baselines the lowest areas on attainment were Literacy, Mathematics and Understanding the World.

Let's Move internal sessions	All EYPP children, were given the chance to attend the weekly dance session to improve their Personal Social and Emotional and Physical skills in a small group activity by nurturing confidence and relationships with others. £1,640	Children with pupil premium performed better than all children in all areas of progress and attainment except for progress in Physical Development and Mathematics, however attainment is very high in these areas. They made the most progress in Communication and Language and Personal, Social and Emotional Development. For attainment the best figures were in Physical Development and Mathematics. The marginally lowest areas for EYPP children for both attainment and progress were in Literacy.
Copies of Core Story	Children were given copies of core stories each half term in order to support language and the love of books in the home learning environment. Progress (expected and accelerated) was an average of 90% across Comprehension and Word Reading and attainment (at and above) across both was at 74%. £1,406	
Imagination Library	All EYPP children and funded two year olds were funded to receive a book every month in the post through the Imagination Library Programme. They will continue to receive this book every month until their 5 th birthday. Progress (expected and accelerated) was an average of 90% across Comprehension and Word Reading and attainment (at and above) across both was at 74%. £651	
Artist in residence.	Our artist in residence attends every Wednesday and supports progress in all areas of the curriculum. £1188.72
