#### Extending children's interests, knowledge and skills

You may have seen your child showing an interest in covering themselves or wrapping up objects, which is an enveloping schema or repeated pattern of play. This schema can be seen in children's actions when they drape themselves in fabric or clothing such as

#### Introducing new knowledge and skills

My Present by Rod Campbell is the core story in red and purple room this half term. It is a colourful young



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children's picture book about presents received for a child's birthday. Each illustration has a flap which links to the enveloping schema that many of the children continue to show interest in.

We will be learning the names of the different objects and using descriptive language to describe them.

### Blue, Yellow and Green Rooms-3-5 year olds

#### Extending children's interests, knowledge and skills



The children in **blue** and **yellow** rooms have been interested in taking the adults on a bear hunt whilst playing outdoors. To build on this interest and deepen their knowledge we will be looking at a different version of the classic story. We will help

the children to use a globe and talk about the different animals in the story and where they live.

The children in **green** room have been singing lots of nursery rhymes and moving their bodies to music. We

have also been exploring how different instruments sound. To deepen their knowledge the children will be developing their body awareness whilst moving to music and learning how to keep healthy.



#### Introducing new knowledge and skills



We're Going on a Lion Hunt written by David Axtell is the core story in blue and yellow room this half term. It is a beautifully illustrated African retelling of the story We're Going on a Bear Hunt which is full of repetition and rhyme. The children will have the opportunity to follow and join in the

girls' excitement as they wade through the grass, splash through the river and squelch through the swamp in search of a lion. We will use the story to sequence and re-enact the roles, through actions and sound. We will think about what happens next and try and recall events from the story. The children will have the opportunity to talk about the lives of people and animals in Africa where the story is set and compare it to here in England. They will also have the chance to use and talk about positional language such as under, over and on.

**Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes** written by Skye Silver is the core story in **green room** this half term. It is an adapted version where we will follow a

family throughout the day in their diverse community as they engage in healthy habits. We will be learning the names of our different body parts as well as how to keep our bodies and minds healthy.



#### How you can help support your child's learning



Please ensure you make use of our wonderful school library. Reading books at home regularly is one of the most important activities you can do to support your child's language
