Five Little Chicks by Lily Murray is the core story in red and purple rooms this half term.

Join this fluffy little family on a beautiful walk through the countryside. Along the

way, they meet all kinds of baby animals and their parents. But wait.. the chicks are disappearing one by one... whatever are they up to? We will be developing the children's awareness of number and developing their language through song and rhyme.

#### How you can help support your child's learning

Songs with actions are great for your child to remember new words and helps them build vocabulary.

#### THIS HALF-TERM IN NURSERY

#### Blue, Yellow and Green Rooms—3-5 year olds

#### Extending children's interests, knowledge and skills

The children in blue and yellow rooms have been

interested in taking care of the different flowers and vegetables seeds we planted in pots. We will extend this learning by visiting our allotment and planting the seedlings into the



raised beds where the children will have the opportunity to watch them grow and change. We will be tasting different fruits and vegetables as well.



In green room, we have been following the children's interest in number. The numbered blocks have been particularly popular with the children. They have been able to stack them vertically and horizontally and place the

numbers in order from 1 to 10. Next half term we will be exploring number further through our core story and on a large scale outdoors.

#### Introducing new knowledge and skills

Our core story this half term in blue and yellow rooms is Handa's Surprise by Eileen Browne.



Following on from our core story
Handa's Hen, we will be listening to another story about
the adventures of Handa. This time she is visiting her
friend Akeyo in the neighbouring village. We will be
talking about the different fruits she has in her basket
and which they like the best. We will be looking at the
various animals that steal fruit from the basket Handa
is carrying on her head. The children will also have the
opportunity to explore different patterns that they
observe on Handa's clothing, listen to a range of African
music and play a variety of African instruments.

#### Ten in the Bed by Penny Dale is the core story in green room this half term.

This is a picture book with a moving, bouncy rhyme linked to number. The children will be exploring loud and quiet noises including, shouting, crashing and




bumping sounds. They will also be exploring numbers 1-10, acting out the rhyme and learning the signs for the animals and the actions in the story.
